Debaters should stick to their allotted times for each section of the debate. If a debater goes over their time, points should be deducted from their "Debate Skills" category points.

Time should be kept as follows:

| Negative Rebuttal (NR) | 6 minutes |
| Affirmative 2 nd Rebuttal | 3 minutes |
