1. Overall Student Performance: (10 points)

- _____ Is the website submitted on a CD? (2 points)
- _____ Did the competitor turn in a short explanation of the website and its content? No more than THREE pages must be included with the submission. The explanation should detail the site's content, what inspired the participant to make it, what development tools were used, and any other pertinent information related to the creation of the site. Judging will be based on the explanation provided in the interview and the site itself. (4 points)
- _____ Was the Competitor on time for the interview? (2 points)
- _____ Was the competitor professionally dressed in Islamic attire? (ex: No Jeans) (2 points)

2. Website Structure (25 points)

- _____ Is website readable using Internet Explorer 5.0 or higher? (1 point)
- _____ Is the overall site appealing and inviting? Can users quickly get the "big picture" of what is offered by the website? (5 points)
- _____ Is the website a model for other web developers? (5 points)
- _____ Does the website function properly? Do the links function properly? Is the site easily accessible without special software/plugin, or are useful help resources or alternatives provided? (7 points)
- _____ Does the website address the needs of the users? (7 points)

3. Content: (25 points)

- _____ Does the content go beyond your basic MSA facts and data? Does it contain information that is useful to MSA members. (8 points)
- _____ Does the website contain a mix of content formats (i.e. text, graphics, photographs, video, audio) to address specific needs? Is there a good balance between text and graphics? (7 points)
- _____ Do all graphics load successfully and quickly? Is the text easy to read? (4 points)
- _____ Is the website free from spelling, grammatical, and other typographical errors? (6 points)
